Reduced Operating Costs and Increase Lift: There are currently FAA certified commercial variants that have demonstrated a 50% reduction in operating costs over the current Turbornecha engine (estimated at over \$300 per flight hour) while increasing takeoff power by over 10%. This is accomplished by producing 807 SHP (Shaft Horse Power) at a 2.5 minute rating, and 780 SHP at take off power. This additional power leads to significant payload increases that will enhance versatility, and allow for additional equipment required for potential forward deployments. b. Reduced Acquisition and Sustainment costs: With overhaul costs of the Turbomecha engine estimated at over \$700,000, the NGB and the US Army can purchase a new engine for less or close to the cost of a Turbomecha engine overhaul. The new commercial engine substantially lowers the current maintenance cost through an on-condition maintenance program that eliminates the engine overhaul cost currently spent on the Turbomecha engine c. Promotes Unit and TASM-G of engine maintenance by providing training, tooling and support to enable organic capabilities within the National Guard and reduce down time d. Increased lift in High Temperatures/High Altitude: Fielded commercial engines have proven increased operational lift capabilities in high temperature /high altitude situations, and can support prolonged operations along Southwest Border, Counter Drug, National Training Center MEDEVAC Missions, Offshore Rescues, and Mountain operations e. Supports Growth in Missions and Potential for Deployments: A new engine supports superior lift capacity, adds future growth in Mission Equipment Packages (MEP), enables rescue /hoist of more rsonnel, and increases future modernization LH-72 potential to support future deployments by overcoming deployment restrictions impacted by lift restrictions on additional protective equipment f. The BCT Task Force has identified the need and requests Logistics Assistance Representatives (LARs) for Army National Guard Brigade Combat Teams (BCTs - Armor, Infantry, and Stryker). Currently TACOM receives funding for LAR TDA authorizations from Department of the Army for support to Active Duty BCTs. Similar requirements exist for ARNG BCT LARs but funding to support these authorizations does not receive the validation, priority, or funding during the Total Army Analysis Process budgeting process.

Request legislative support for additional funding and/or legislative influence directed to Department of the Army to make LAR support to ARNG BCTs a higher priority for funding consideration in order to provide a similar level of support to ARNG BCTs with the ARNG's role as as the operational reserve in support of the Army.

- 1. Under the 2008 National Defense Authorization Act, members of the Reserve Component who served at least 90 days during a fiscal year on a deployment in support of overseas operations such as the Iraq or Afghanistan campaigns are authorized to retire three months early for each 90 day period they served in any given fiscal year. This only applies to members of the Guard or Reserves who participated in a qualifying active-duty mobilization after Jan. 28, 2008, which is the date the Act was signed into law. Service on or before this date does not count toward early retirement.
- 2. In January 2013, Congress expanded the criteria for early retirement by authorizing additional eligibility requirements. The new rules allow members of the Guard or Reserves to count activations for national emergencies including natural disasters such as earthquakes, hurricanes, tornadoes, floods, etc. Members of the Reserve Components may also be eligible to retire early if they were in a Warrior Transition unit and were injured while mobilized for responses as mentioned above.
- 3. The 2015 National Defense Authorization Act further expanded benefits. The 2015 NDAA removed the requirement for the 90 days of active duty service to be performed within the same fiscal year - activations could cross into consecutive years.
- 4. Despite Congress intent to provide recognition of the impacts of numerous deployments have on the careers of national Guardsman and Reservists, the laws have been interpreted to apply only to receiving Retired pay and do not apply to receiving TRICARE.
- 5. With Traditional Guardsman such a system creates another hurdle after 20 years they can become Gray Area retirees without pay, then an Early Retiree with no medical, the finally to reach age 60 where they finally receive similar benefits that their active duty counterparts have enjoyed from the time they retired.
- 6. Recommend that the National Guard Bureau and Department of Defense weigh the small numbers that this likely affects in the force today versus the administrative and stigma this creates to enable eligibility of TRICARE when you are eligible for Retired pay.
- 7. Recommend that Congress act to amend the law to make TRICARE Eligibility concurrent with Retired Pay Eligibility.
